# This week someone has *said something kind to me*



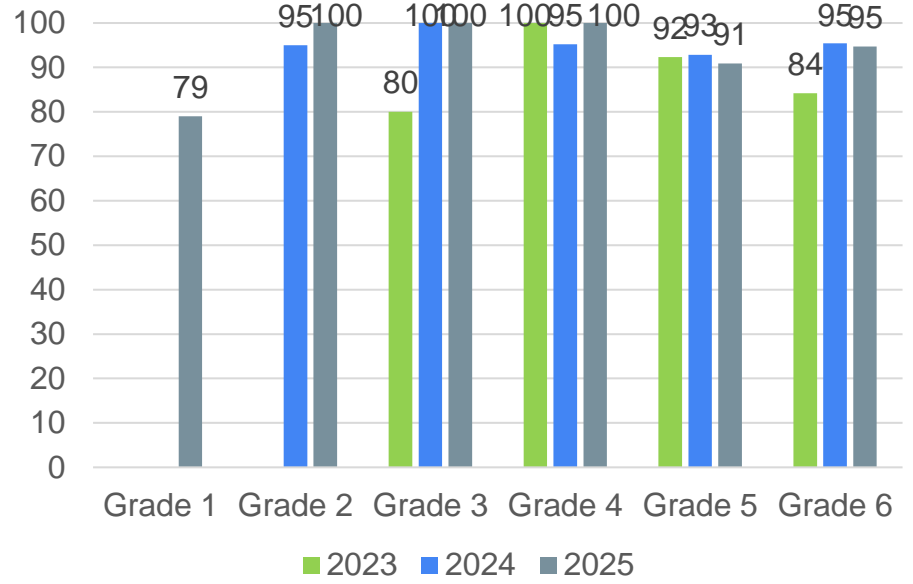
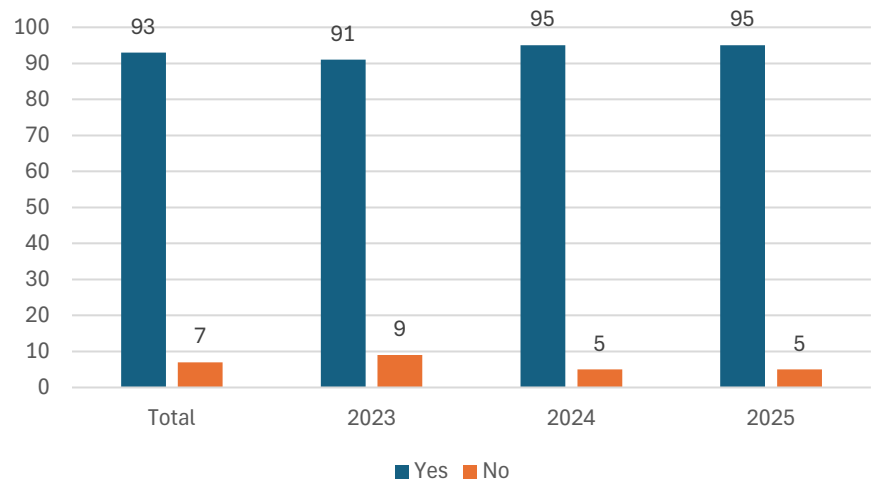
There is a 4% decrease in the occurrence of this behavior in 2025 compared to 2024. The biggest decreases are seen in Grade 4 and Grade 6. However, there is also 15% increase in Grade 2.

# This week someone has *tried to hurt me*



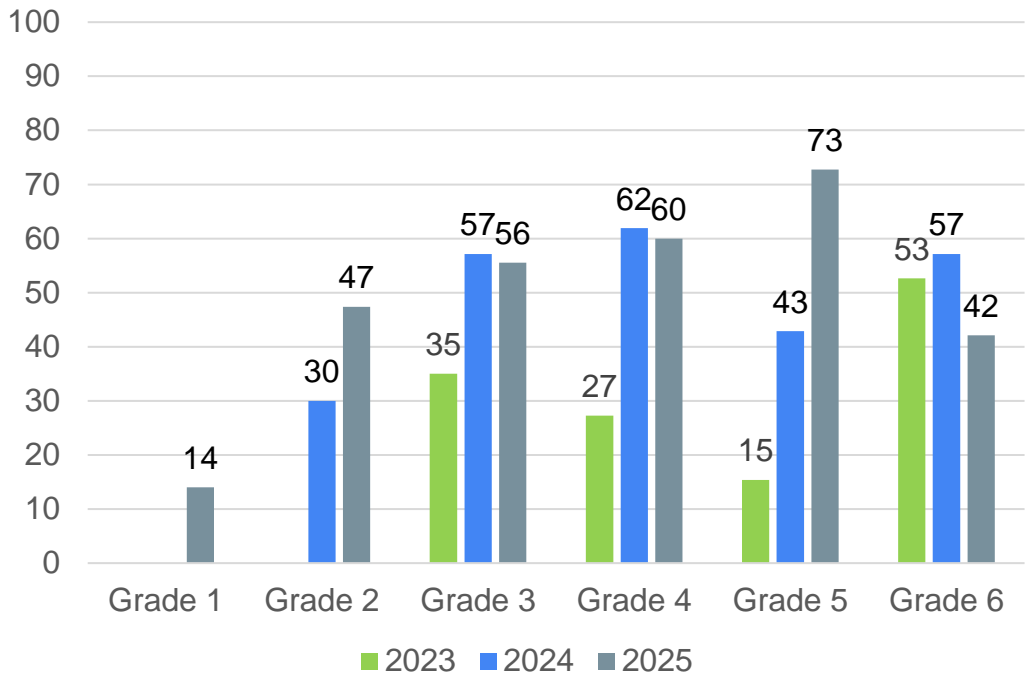
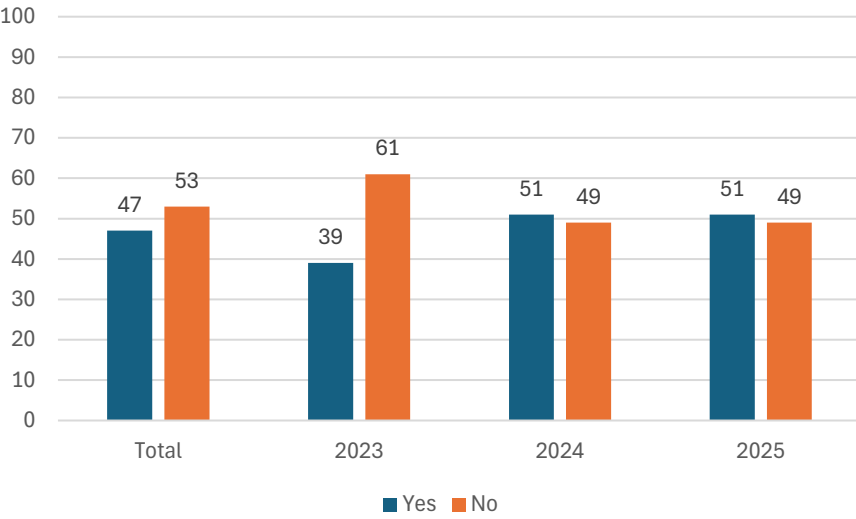
There is a 11% increase in the occurrence of this behavior in 2025 compared to 2024. This increase primarily occurs in Grade 2 (+27%). However, the other grades also experience an increase in this negative behavior, except Grade 6, which experience a significant decrease (-21%).

# This week someone has *smiled at me*



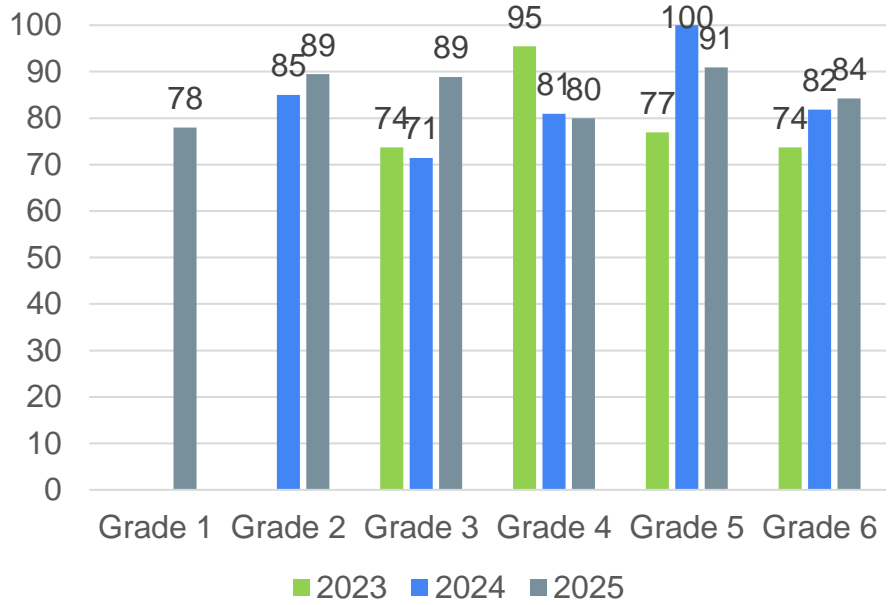
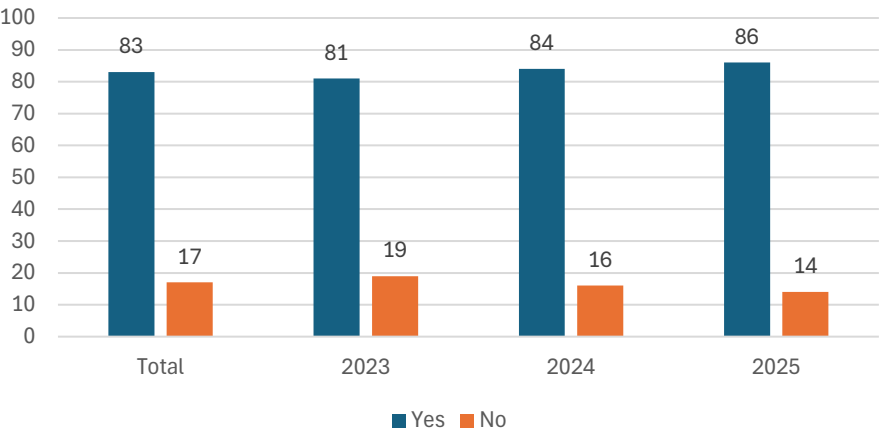
In total, the occurrence of this behavior stays the same in 2025 compared to 2024. However, Grade 1 has lowest score compare the other classes.

# This week someone has *said something unkind*



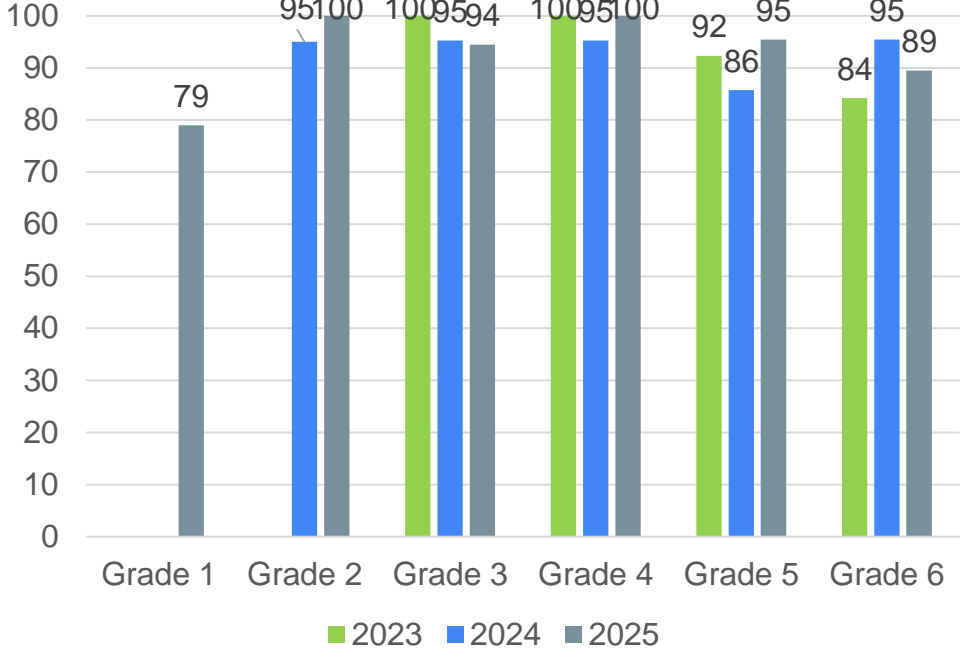
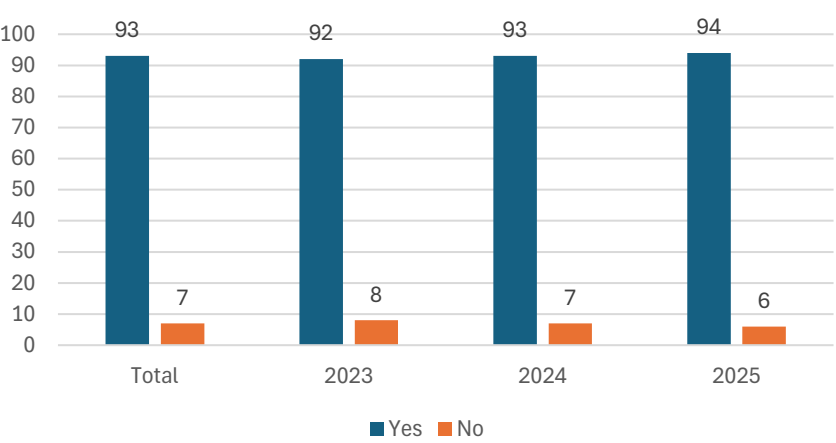
In total, the occurrence of this behavior stays the same in 2025 compared to 2024. However, Grade 5 and Grade 2 experience significant increase, +30%, and +17%, respectively. Grade 6, on the other hand, experience 15% of decrease in this behavior.

# This week someone has *shared something with me*



There is a %2 increase in the occurrence of this behavior in 2025 compare to 2024; most of the grades experience an increase, especially in Grade 3. However, there is a 9% decrease in Grade 5. Also, Grade 1 has the lowest percentage.

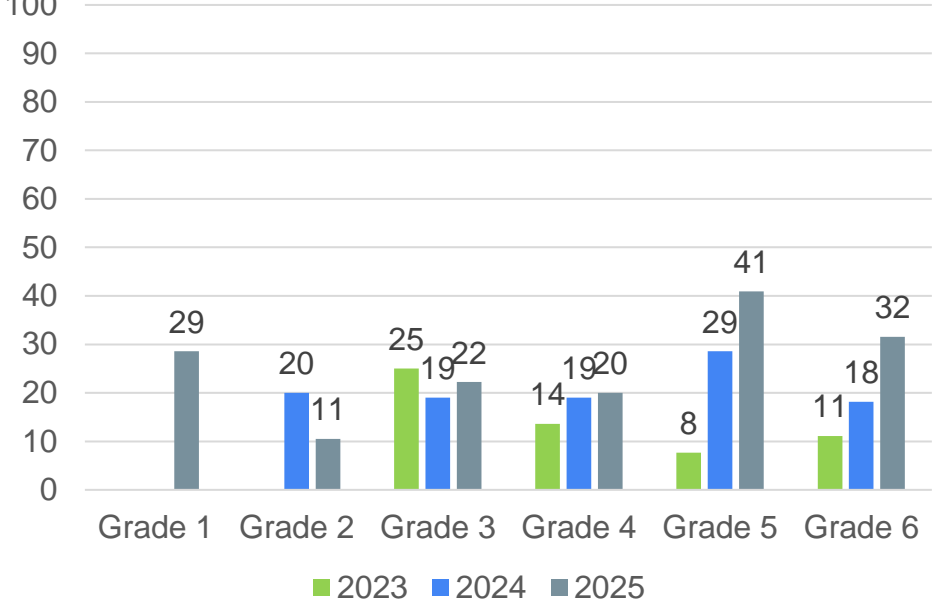
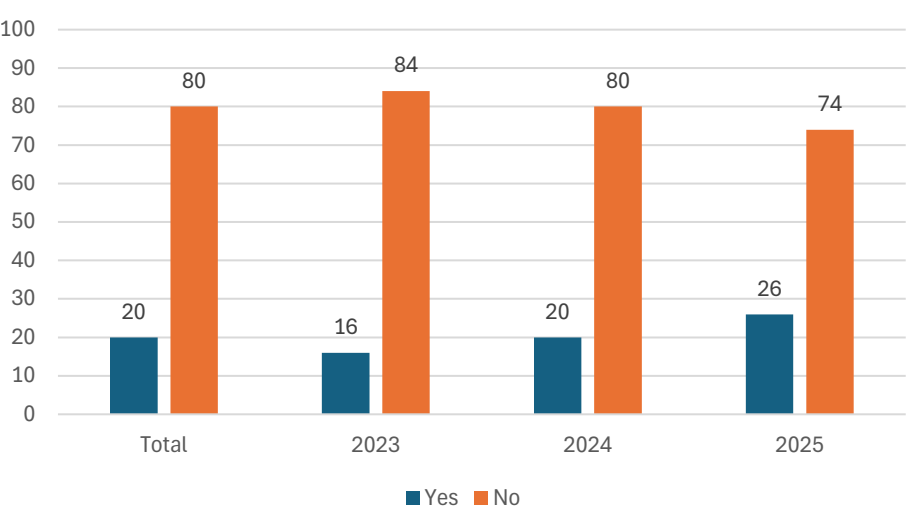
# This week someone has *played a game with me*



There is a %1 increase in the occurrence of this behavior in 2025 compare to 2024. There is an 6% drop in Grade 6.

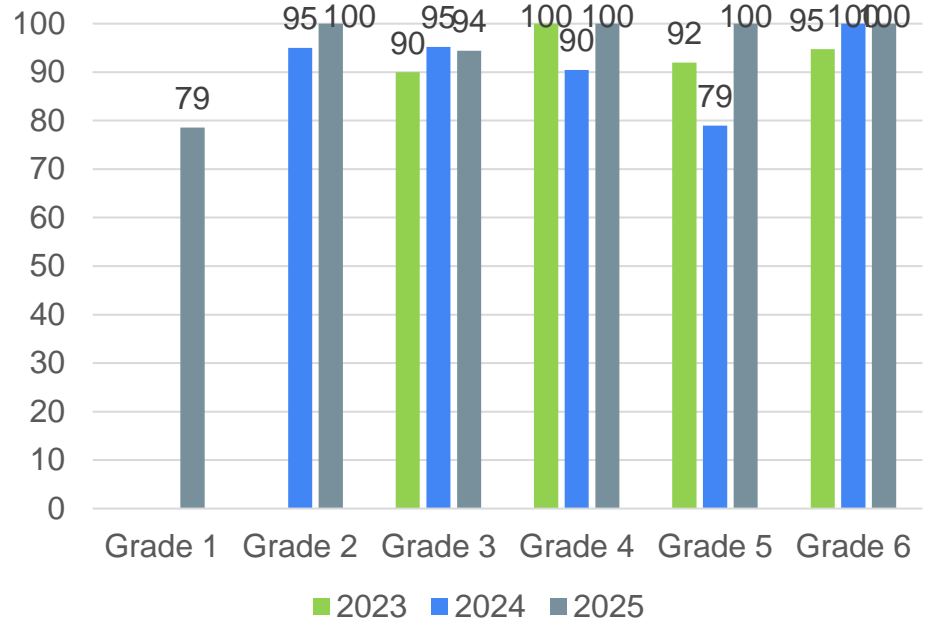
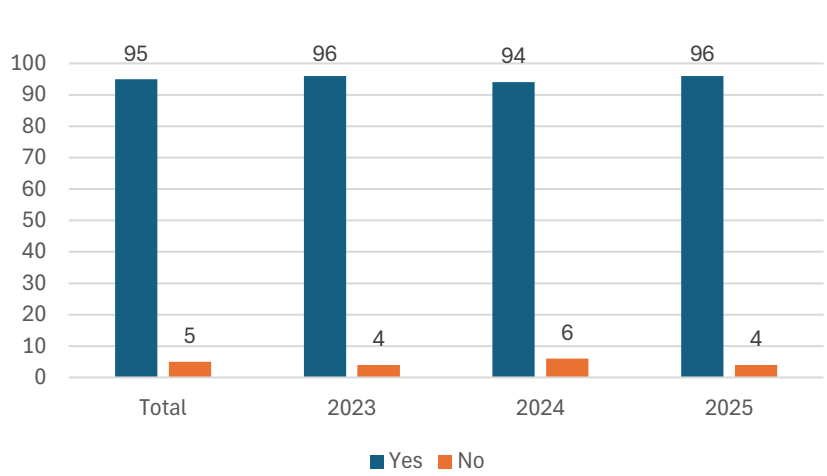


# This week someone has *taken something from me*



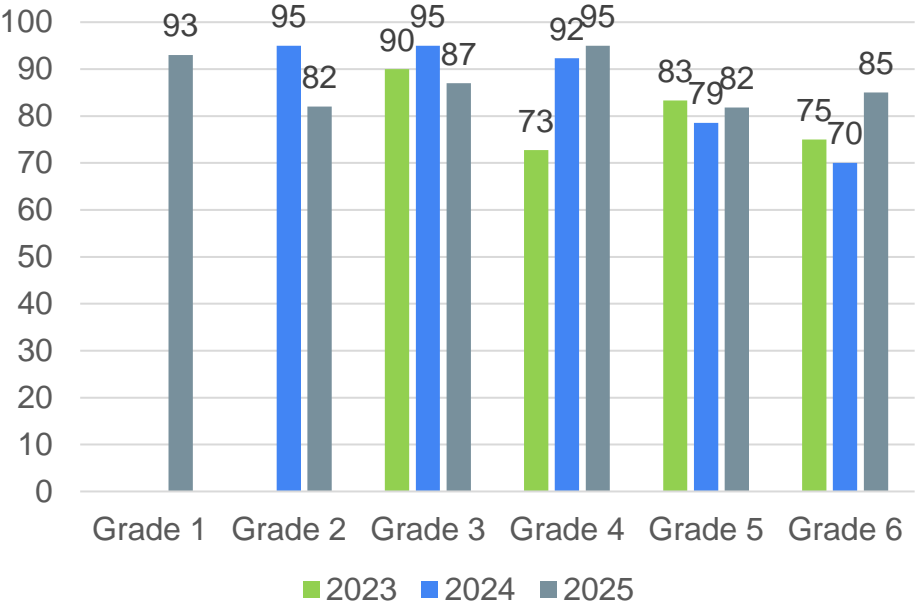
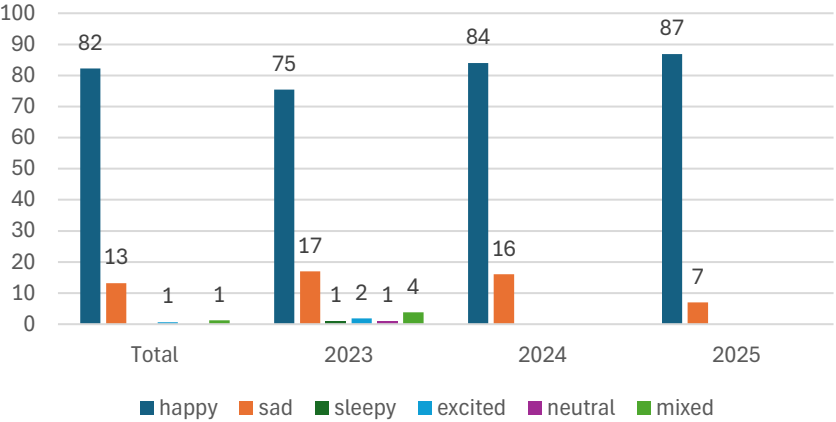
There is a %6 increase in the occurrence of this behavior in 2025 compare to 2024. There is a big jump in Grade 5 and Grade 6, with 12% and 14% respectively.

There is a %2 increase in the occurrence of this behavior in 2025 compare to 2024; there is a 21% increase in Grade 5.

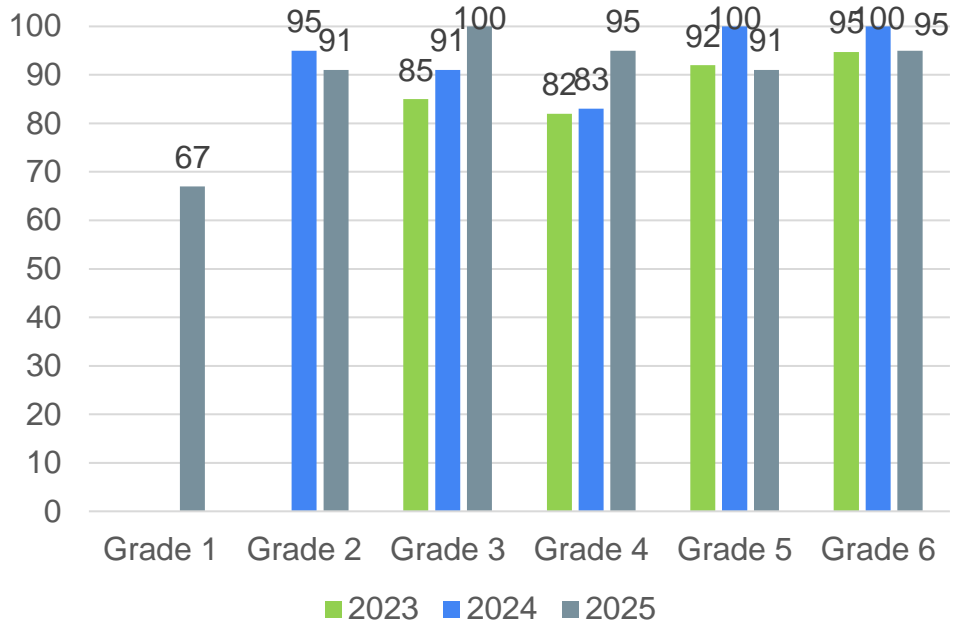
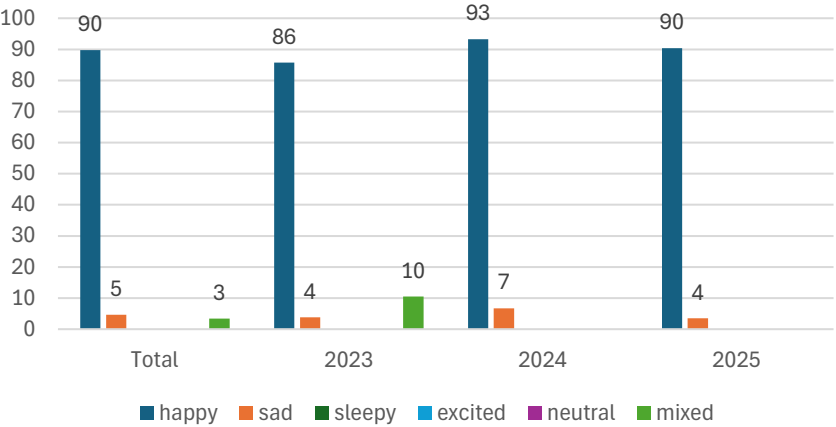
# In the last week I have felt *on my way to school*

# In the last week I have felt *when I'm in the playground*

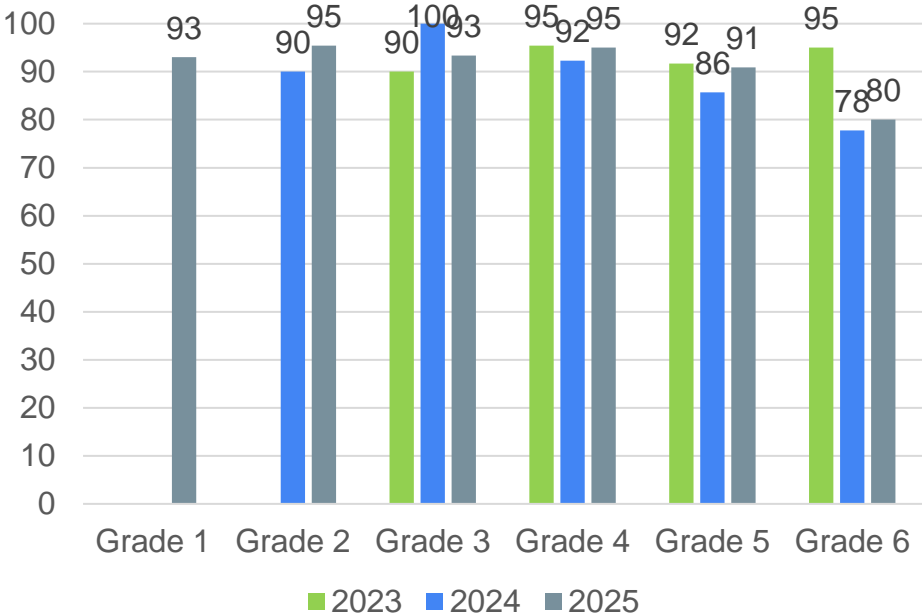
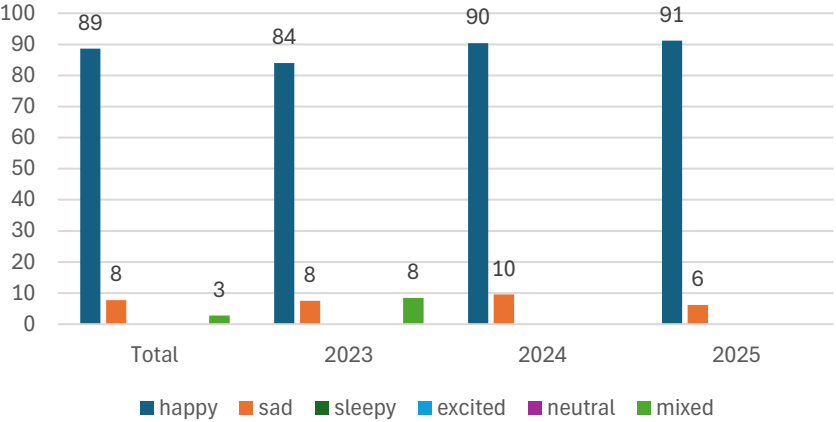


The students are more happy in the playgrounds (however, 3% decrease in 2025).

The biggest increases are seen in Grade 3, Grade 4.

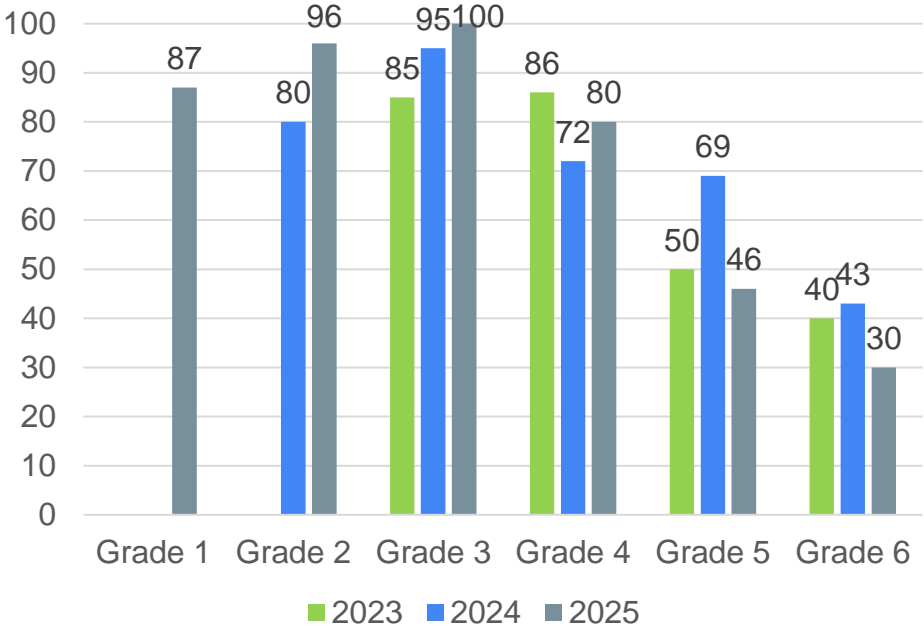
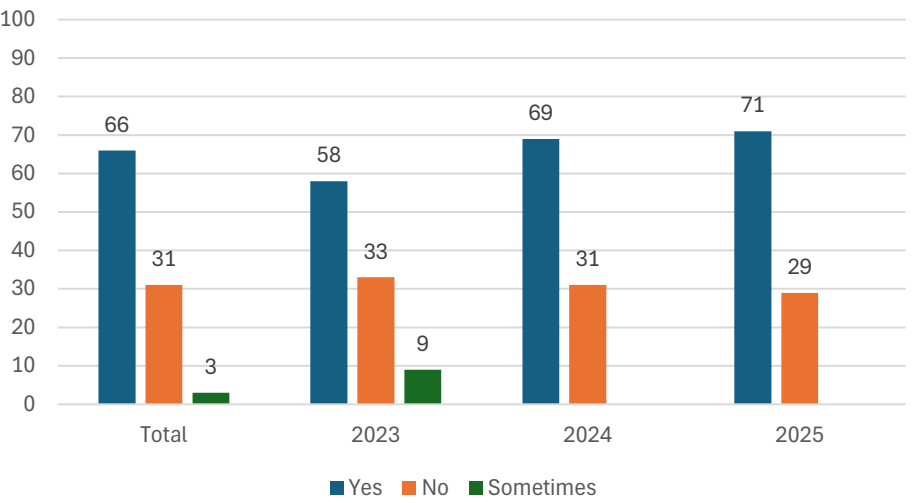
The Grade 1 has the lowest percentage.

The students are more happy in their classrooms. (1% increase in 2025).

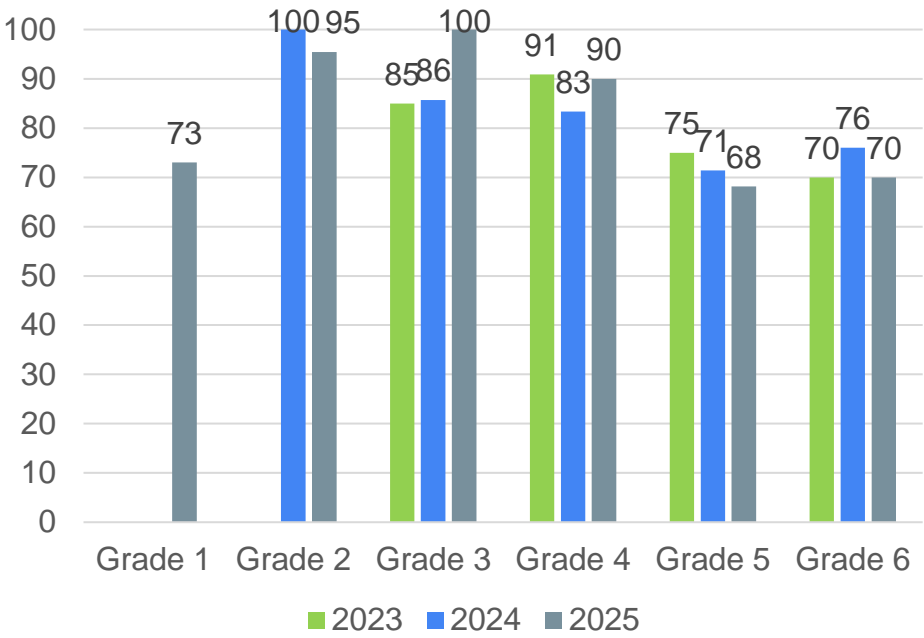
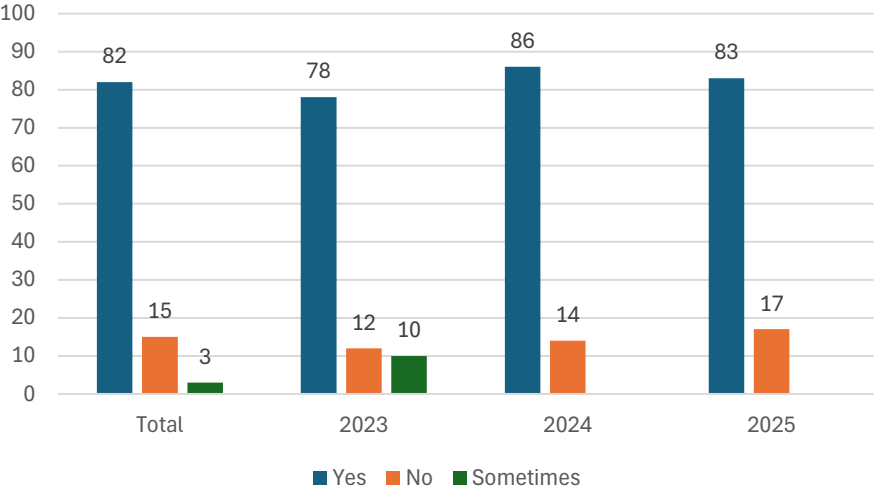
# Do you tell a *teacher* when you are *sad* ?



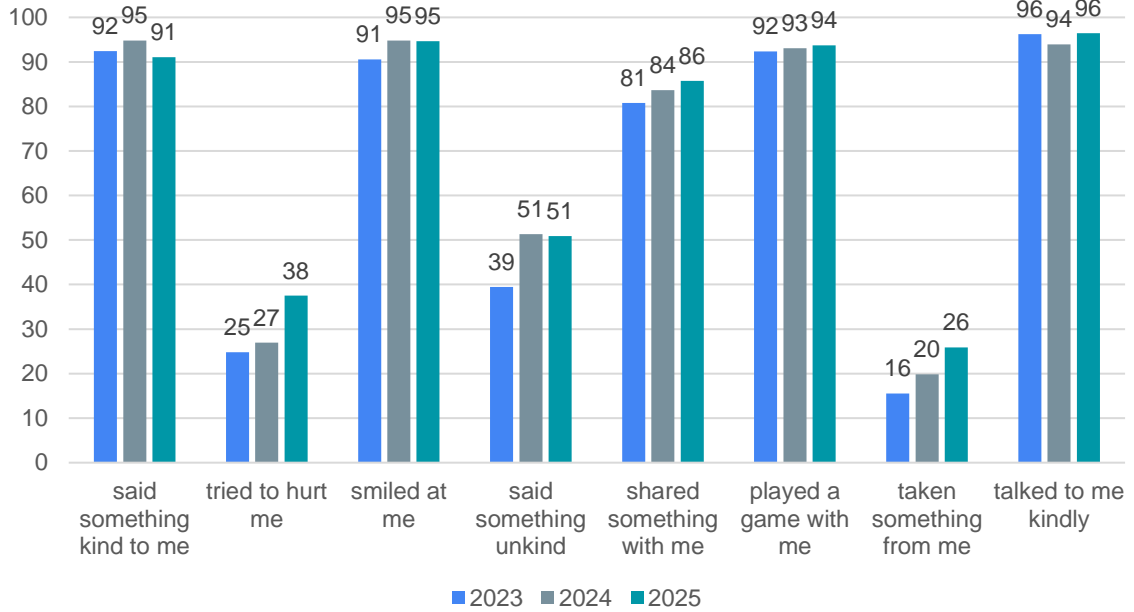
The students share their feelings to teachers more frequently in 2025 (+2 % increase).

*All positive behaviors have higher percentages (>85) in 2025.*



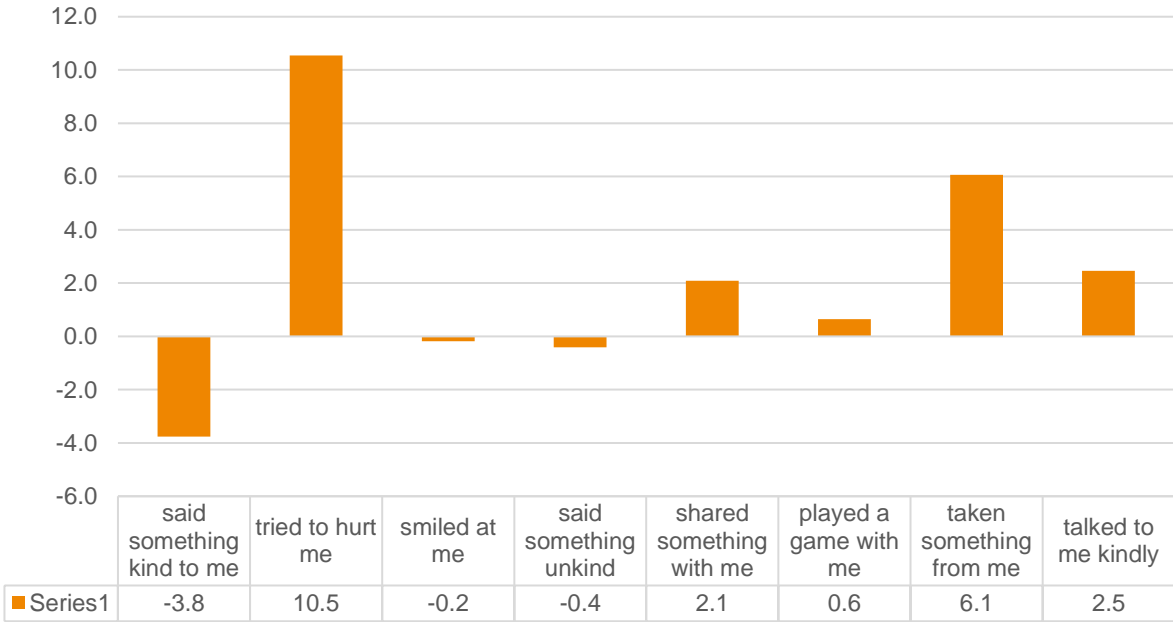
# Summary 2: Yearly Comparison of *Percentages of «Yes»*

All positive behaviors have higher percentages (>85). Among all statements, «*shared something with me*» has the lowest score.



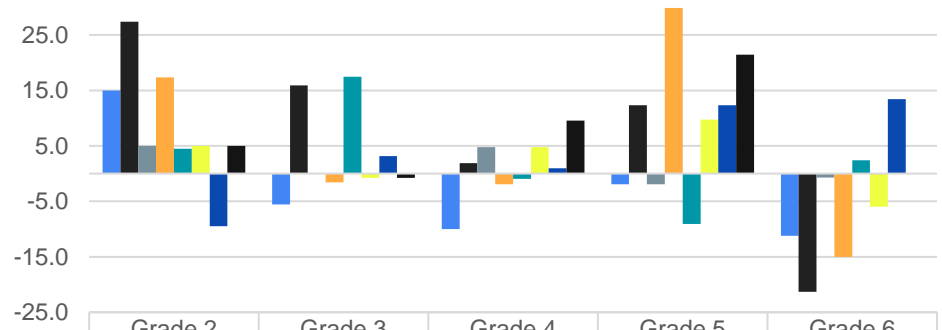
There is a slight increase of occurrence in all *negative* behaviors in 2025. Among them «*said something unkind*» has highest percentage, but stays the same.

### Summary 3: Difference between 2024 & 2025-Percentages of «Yes»



- There is a significant increase in two negative behaviors; «*tried to hurt me*» and «*taken something from me*».
- There is a significant decrease in «*said something kind to me*».
- There is an increase in two positive behaviors; «*talked to me kindly*» and «*shared something with me*».

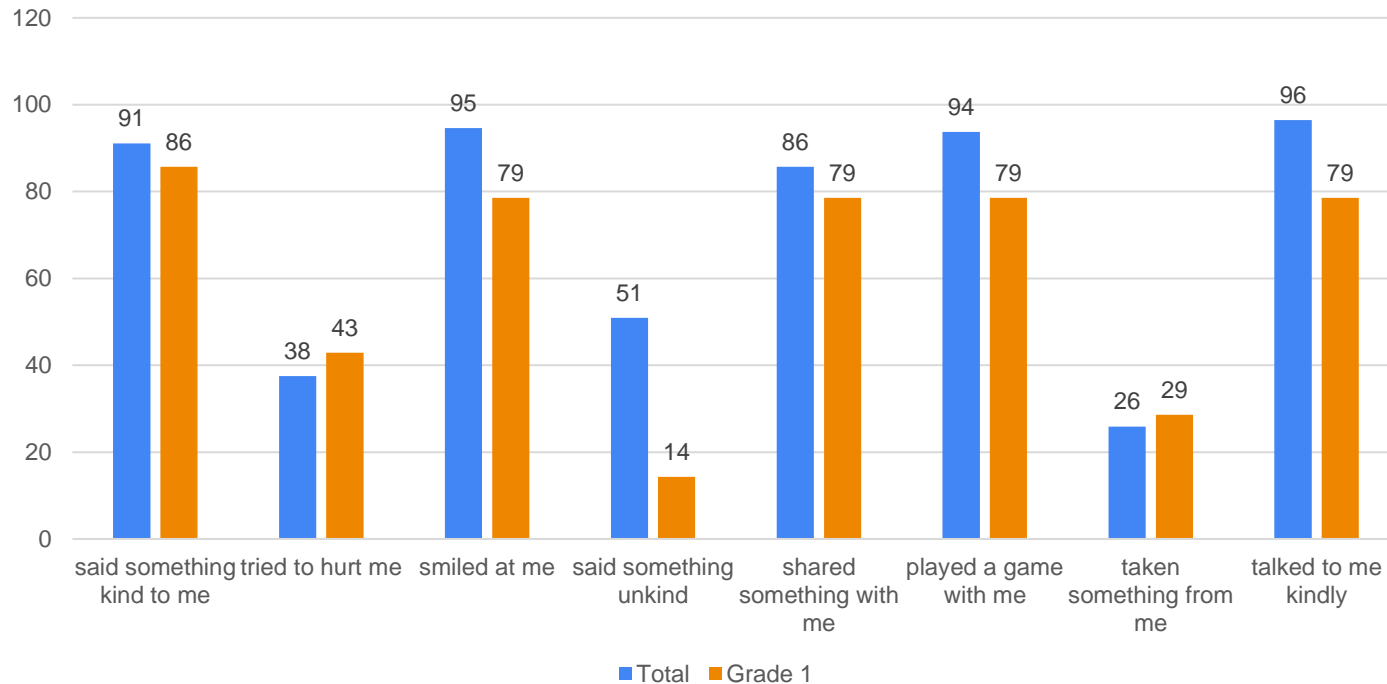
# Summary 4: Difference between 2024 & 2025 by Grade-Percentages of «Yes»

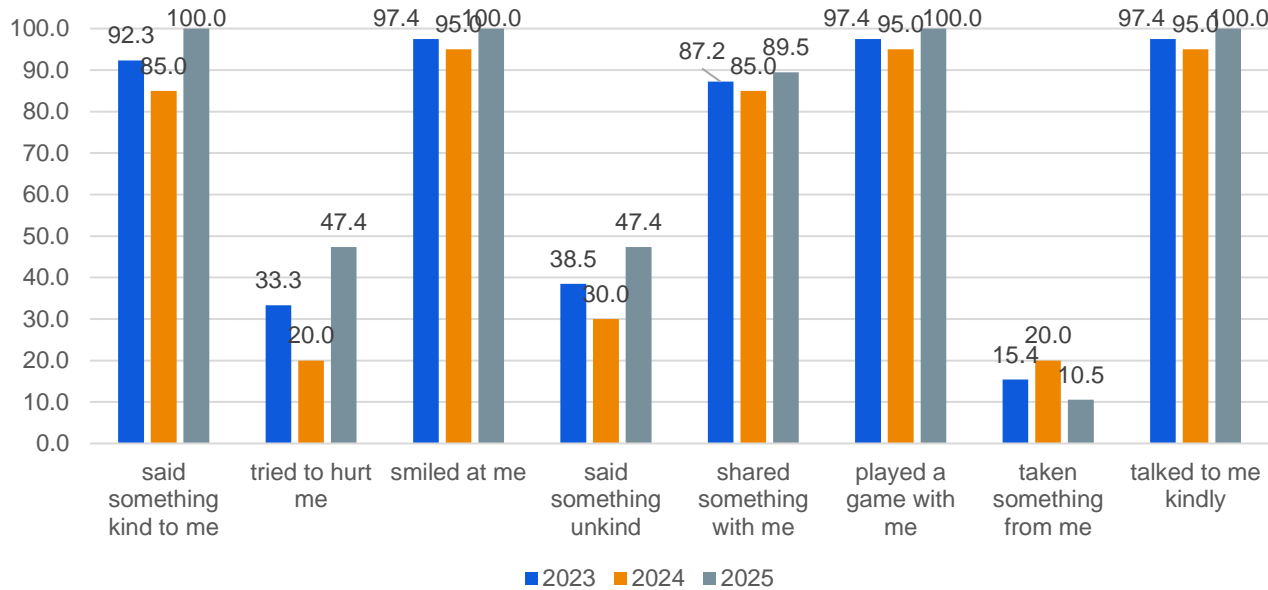
- All classes have experienced a decrease in the occurrence of «said something unkind», except Grade 2 and Grade 5.
- Almost all classes have experienced an increase in the occurrence of «tried to hurt me», except Grade 6.
- Grade 5 has experienced a big jump in the occurrence of «said something unkind», and a big drop in «talked to me kindly».
- Grade 6 has experienced a big drop in the occurrence of «tried to hurt me» and «said something unkind», and an increase in «taken something from me».

## Summary 5: Percentages of «Yes» - Grade 1



Compare to the total percentages, Grade 1 has lower scores in all positive behaviors. Also, it has higher scores in negative behaviors, except «said something unkind».

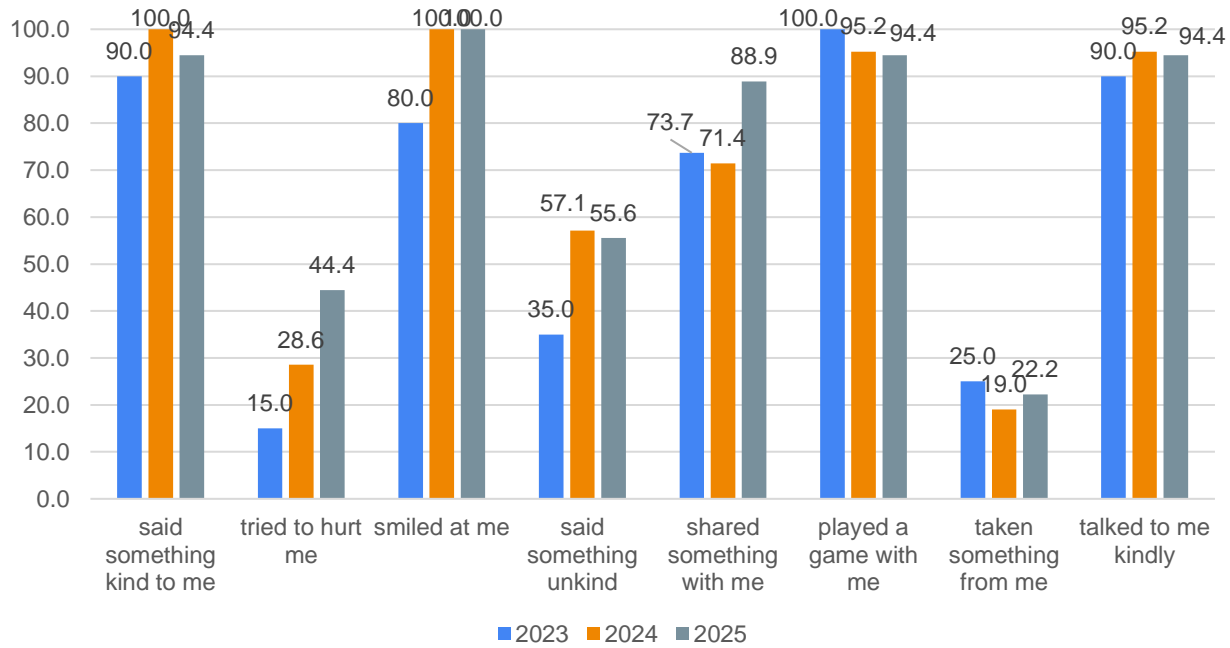
# Summary 6: Comparison of 2023,2024 and 2025– Percentages of «Yes» - Grade 2



In 2025;

- There were improvements observed in all positive behaviors.
- There were increase in two negative behaviors, «said something unkind to me», and «tried to hurt me». There was an decrease in «taken something from me».

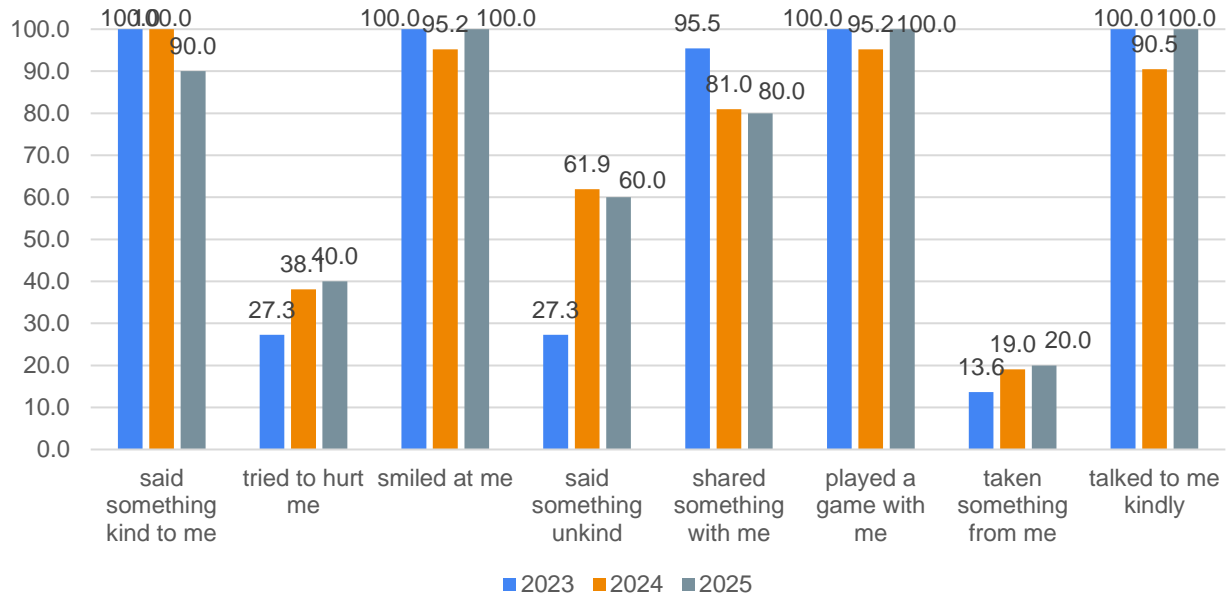
Summary 7: Comparison of 2023,2024 and 2025– Percentages of «Yes» - Grade 3



In 2025;

- There were a slight decrease in most of the positive behaviors, except «shared something with me».
- There were increase in negative behaviors, except in «said something unkind» with a small increase.

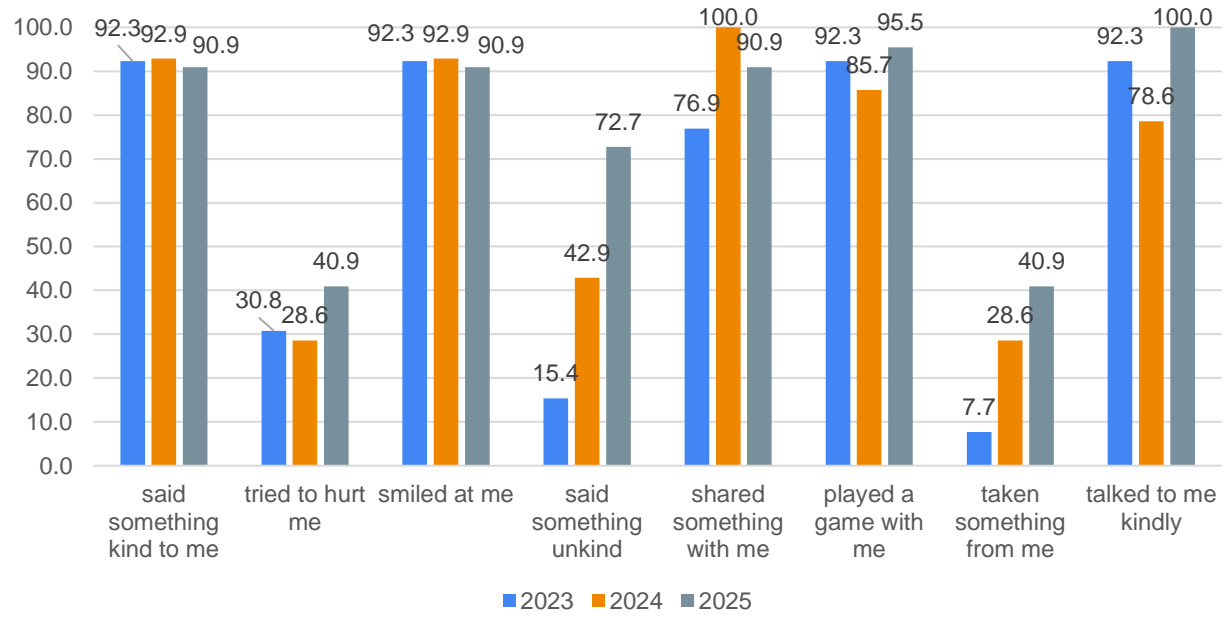
Summary 8: Comparison of 2023,2024 and 2025– Percentages of «Yes» - **Grade 4**



In 2025;

- There were increases in most of the positive behaviors, except «said something kind to me», and «shared something with me».
- There were increases in all negative behaviors, except «said something unkind».

# Summary 9: Comparison of 2023,2024 and 2025– Percentages of «Yes» - Grade 5

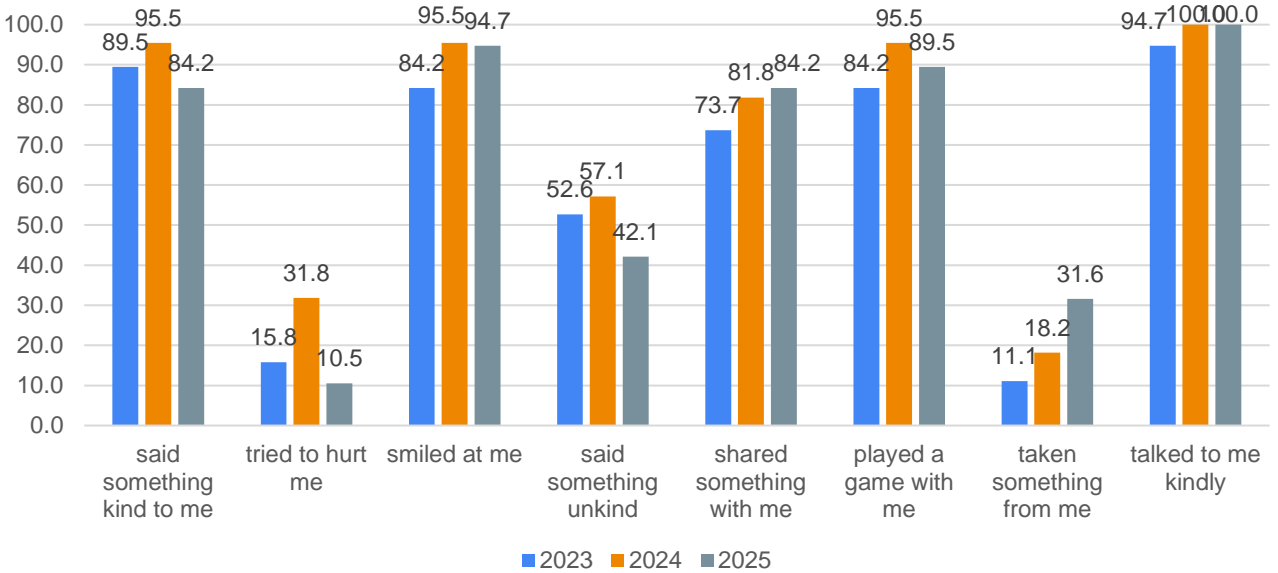


In 2025;

- *There were significant improvements in «smiled at me» and «talked to me kindly».*
- *There were increase in all negative behaviors.*



Summary 10: Comparison of 2023,2024 and 2025– Percentages of «Yes» - Grade 6



In 2025;

- There were decreases in almost all positive behaviors, exceptions are «talked to me kindly» and «shared something with me».
- There was a decrease in «tried to hurt me» with %20.

## OVERALL

- All positive behaviors have higher percentages (>85). Also, there is a **small improvement** in all positive attitudes in 2025, except «**said something kind to me**».
- There is a slight increase of occurrences in two **negative** behaviors in 2025; «**tried to hurt me**», «**taken something from me**».
- All classes have experienced a decrease in the occurrence of «**said something unkind**», except Grade 2 and 5, with +30% in Grade 5. **So, this class needs more attention for this behavior.**
- Almost all classes have experienced an increase in the occurrence of «**tried to hurt me**», except Grade 6. Grade 6 experiences a significant decrease (-21%) of the occurrence of «**tried to hurt me**».
- Grade 1 has the lowest score compare the other classes of **smiled at me with** (79%) and **shared something with me** (78%). **This class seems to need more attention.**
- Grade 2 experiences a 15% increase in the occurrence of «**said something kind to me**». However, this class also experiences an increase (+27%) in one of the negative behaviors; «**tried to hurt me**».
- Grade 3 has experienced an increase of 18% on the occurrence of «**shared something with me** ».
- Grade 5 has experienced an increase of 21% on the occurrence of «**talked to me kindly**».
- Grade 5 and Grade 6 have experienced a big jump in the occurrence of «**taken something from me**». **So, this behavior should be addressed.**
- Around 71% of the student shared their feeling with their teacher, and 83% of them shared their feeling with their parents.
- The students expresses that they are mostly **happy** in 2025;
  - on their way to school (87%),
  - in the playgrounds (90%),
  - in their classrooms. (91%).
